KATHMANDU WALDORF KINDERGARTEN - PARENT & TEACHER SHARED COMMUNITY COMMITMENT DURING COVID PANDEMIC

It is important that families, teachers, and staff acknowledge and understand the responsibility towards each other as we move towards reopening. As we reopen our kindergarten everyone must agree that our actions and choices have an impact on those around us.

- 1. Adults are required to wear a mask and adhere to physical distancing guidelines in school. Please bring your own masks and always have a spare labelled mask at school for your child.
- 2 .Do not bring your child to school if they have any covid symptoms. (cough, cold, congestion, fever, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, body ache). Please check your child's temperature daily before coming to school. If your child shows symptoms whilst at school or runs a temperature the child will be isolated and will be sent home.
- 3.If anyone at home is showing covid symptoms, or have taken a PCR, do not send your child to school before getting a negative result.
- 4.If anyone at home has tested positive, including the domestic help, the child should remain home for 5 days and can come to school after a negative antigen test.
- 5.If the child is positive, he/she must not come to school for 7 days. If symptoms persist, they should stay home until no symptoms are seen for 48 hours.
- 6.If the child has travelled outside the country, they must quarantine for 5 days before coming to school.
- 7.All illness must be reported for necessary quarantine actions to be implemented.
- 8.If any child in the class tests positive, the entire class including the teachers will quarantine for 5 days.
